



If your facility has a Technology Administrator, please make sure that person has the following information for the installation of BrainWare Safari. LEC employees should not be involved with the installation of BWS unless the proper permission is granted.

- BrainWare Safari is a rich-client application.
- It is installed on the local machine and does not require the CD once the installation has been completed. However, it does require a connection to the Internet when it is played.
- It requires Administrator access to install but not to play.
- For most installations, BrainWare Safari is installed to ALL USERS. In some cases, it may be necessary to move it to the All Users folder. For Mac users, the security settings may need to be changed to allow all users rights to read and execute.
- If your facility has a firewall or proxy server you will need to allow port 80 traffic **to and from** <http://brainwareforyou.com> and <http://72.3.142.180>. You may need to specifically allow this address in the filter.
- If your network uses a content filter, you may need to add <http://brainwareforyou.com> and <http://72.3.142.180> to the filter as allowed sites.
- While BrainWare Safari will operate over slower connections (e.g., dial-up and older DSL modems), those connections may not have sufficient speed for a large number of users at the same time. We recommend a connection with a speed of at least 512 kbps for multiple users and a high speed connection, such as a T-1 line, when a classroom or more students will be using the program simultaneously.
